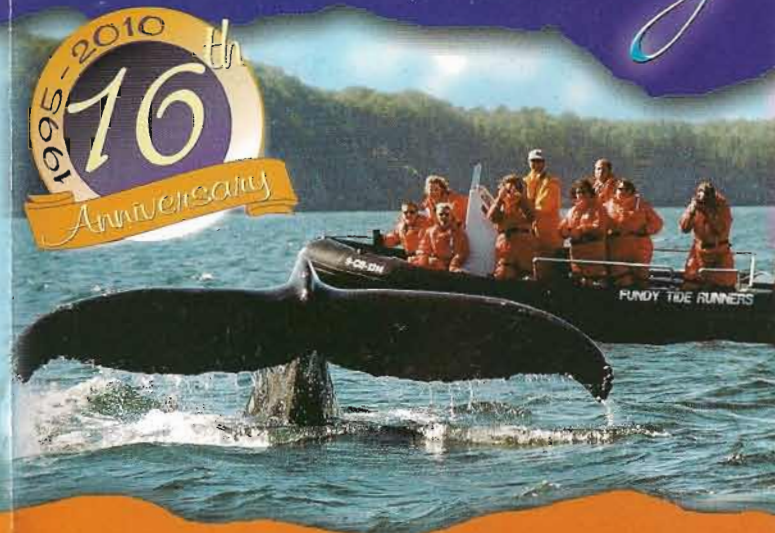

Fundy Tide Runners is situated in a century-old loft, located in the Day Adventure Centre beside Market Wharf. Established in 1995, we have provided fifteen years of safe and enjoyable whale watching adventures. Fundy Tide Runners is signatory to the Bay of Fundy Whale Watchers Code of Ethics, which fosters respect for wildlife and its habitat. The vessel will slow or stop to allow passengers to observe local wildlife, to take photos and to ask questions. Fundy Tide Runners

is proud to be a Bay of Fundy Recommended Experience as awarded by the Bay of Fundy Tourism Partnership. This award is an earned designation and Fundy Tide Runners is committed to sustainable tourism and quality whale watch experiences. Our success rating for whale sightings averages 95%.

YOUR VESSEL

Tide Runner is a 24-foot, rigid-hulled Zodiac Hurricane™ and is powered by a 200 hp turbo-charged inboard/outboard diesel engine. **Tide Runner's** power and speed enable us to find whales and other wildlife wherever they may be. The vessel is constructed to military standards and consists of a deep "V" fiberglass bottom, surrounded by a five-chamber inflated hypalon collar. **Tide Runner** is equipped with radar, chart plotters, GPS, two radios, cell phone and dual depth sounders, which provide for safe and secure operation in all weather. **Tide Runner** is always kept in top running order offering the fastest and most exciting whale watching experience in the entire Bay.

The bilingual captain is a Canadian Coast Guard Auxiliary trained captain and has extensive knowledge and years of experience in local waters.

YOUR SAFETY

Your safety is important to us. To have fun you must feel safe and secure. Safety starts with the boat. The Canadian Coast Guard uses our exact vessel model as their high-speed rescue craft. Our vessel's safety gear meets or exceeds Transport Canada regulations. Each passenger over 90 lbs. is provided with a Canadian approved full length Mustang™ flotation suit for safety and comfort. Sizes range from xs-xxl. Children under 90 lbs. are provided with a Canadian approved personal flotation device (PFD), and need to be dressed warmly. We are unable to carry children less than five (5) years of age.

COME EXPERIENCE THE BAY!!

After a short trip briefing you will depart from the wharf in historic St. Andrews on your whale watching adventure. **Tide Runner** will weave its way through the bays and island channels on its route to search the Fundy coastal waters for whales and other marine wildlife.

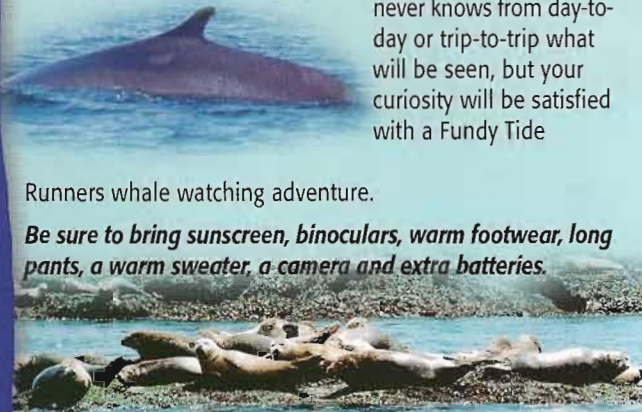
The world's highest twice-daily tides stir up a bounty of food in local waters, which attracts several species of migratory whales. Species that you sight may include the Minke whale (12-30ft), Finback whale (35-75ft) and Humpback whale (35-55ft), as well as harbour porpoises, harbour seals, Atlantic puffins, bald eagles, razorbills, black guillemots and other pelagic sea birds.

Explore the history and culture of the rich fishery which includes lobster fishing, herring weirs and salmon farms. You will have a rare opportunity for a safe and exciting marine adventure. One

never knows from day-to-day or trip-to-trip what will be seen, but your curiosity will be satisfied with a Fundy Tide

Runners whale watching adventure.

Be sure to bring sunscreen, binoculars, warm footwear, long pants, a warm sweater, a camera and extra batteries.



F.A.Q's

Is your boat safe? Yes. The Zodiac Hurricane™ is a standard in marine safety and provides a safe, stable and exciting whale watching experience.

Are you restricted as to where you can go in search of whales? No. We have the speed and knowledge to take you where the large whales are. Not all boats can range offshore due to licensing and speed restrictions. *Be sure to ask other operators about their boat's limitations.*

Do we guarantee sightings? No. The ocean is not an aquarium and no operator can guarantee whale sightings. You have our personal guarantee that you will have a great trip and a 95% average chance of sighting whales.
